- Harsh, scolding words track with parenting focus on control
- Restraint, pleasant words and understanding track focus on nurture

- Reflects a life of faith
- Reflects confidence in God
- Fear of the Lord brings wisdom Proverbs 9:10 Proverbs 15:33

Means of Communication: Restraint

Proverbs 17:27

Quiet Speech: Ecclesiastes 9:17

Avoid too many words:

Ecclesiastes 6:11, Proverbs 10:19

Think first, Speak second:

Proverbs 15:28 Proverbs 29:20

Manner of Communication: Pleasant words

Pleasant words promote instruction Proverbs 16:21

Pleasant words are a honeycomb Proverbs 16: 23, 24

Wise tongue commends knowledge Proverbs 15:2

Goal of Communication: Understanding

The finest art of communication: not the ability to express your thoughts, but the ability to understand your kids

Proverbs 18:2 A fool finds no pleasure in understanding but delights in airing his own opinions.
